shall stand reverted to the Province to which he is allocated under the Proivnce of West Pakistan (Dissolution) Order, 1970 (P. O. No. 1 of 1979, "; and

(2) After subsection (1-B), the following new subsection shall be added,

namely :-

"(1-C) Any order of removal or termination of service passed by the Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1-A), shall not be called in question in any proceedings taken under the Industrial Relations Ordinance, 1969 (XXIII of 1969), or the Essential Services (Maintenance) Act, 1952 (LIII of 1952), or under any law for the time being in force, before any Court, Tribunal or Commission and any order passed by any Court, Tribunal or Commission after the thirtieth day of September 1975, and before the coming into force of the West Paklstan Water and Power Development Authority (Amendment) Ordinance, 1979, setting aside or modifying or declaring any order of the Authority to be void and of no effect, shall stand vacated."

## PRESIDENT'S ORDER 24 OF 1979

EMPLOYEES OF THE PAKISTAN WATER AND POWER DEVELOP-MENT AUTHORITY (ALLOCATION TO PROVINCES) ORDER, 1979

[Gazette of Pakistan, Extraordinary, Part I, 29th December 1979]

No. F. 17 (2)/79-Pub.—The following Order made by the President is hereby published for general information:—

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 20 of the Province of West Pakistan (Dissolution) Order, 1970 (P. No. 1 of 1970), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to make the following Order:—

- 1. Short title and Commencement.—(1) This Order may be called the Employees of the Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority (Allocation to Provinces) Order, 1979.
  - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Allocation of employees of Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority to Provinces.—All persons serving in connection with the affairs of the Government of West Pakistan in the Electricity and Irrigation Department who were required to serve under the Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority under subsection (1) of section 17 of the Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority Act, 1958 (West Pakistan Act XXXI of 1958), are allocated to the Provinces where they were serving at the time of the creation of the Province of West Pakistan or, if they were appointed by the Government of West Pakistan after the creation of that Province, to the Provinces of their permanent residence.

## ORDINANCE LXXIII OF 1979

CIGARETTES (PRINTING OF WARNING) ORDINANCE, 1979

An Ordinance to provide for printing of a health warning on packets of cigarettes

[Gazette of Pakistan, Extraordinary, Part 1, 31st December 1979]

No. F. 17 (1)/79-Pub.—The following Ordinance made by the President is hereby published for general information:—

WHERBAS it is expedient to provide for printing of a health warning on packets of cigarettes and for matters connected there with;

AND WHEREAS the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

Now, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July 1977, read with the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977 (C.M.L.A. Order No. 1 of 1977), and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

- 1. Short title, extent and commencement.—(1) This Ordinance may be culled the Cigarettes (Printing of Warning) Ordinance, 1979.
  - (2) It extends to the whole of Pakistan.
  - (3) It shall come into force on the first day of July 1980.
- 2. Definitions.—In this Ordinance, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—
  - (a) "Cigarette" includes Biri;
  - (b) "Health warning" means the health warning specified in section 3; and
  - (c) "Packet" includes a wrapper or other container.
- 3. Printing of health warning.—There shall be printed legibly and prominently, both in English and Urdu, on every packet of cigarettes the following health warning, namely:—

"WARNING: Smoking is injurious to health.

عبردار تمباكو صحت كے لئے سفر ہے .

الزارت صعت" . "Ministry of Health".

- 4. Prohibition to sell, etc.—No person shall—
- (a) manufacture packets of cigarettes, or
- (b) sell or offer for sale cigarettes from packets of cigarettes, or
- (c) possess or sell or offer for sale packets of cigarettes, on which the warning is not printed as required by section 3.
- 5. Penalties.—(1) Whoever contravenes any provision of section 4 shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years, or with fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees, or with both.
- 2. Where a Court convicts a person of an offence punishable under subsection (1), it shall direct that the packets of cigarettes and the cigarettes it respect of which the offence has been committed be forfeited to the Federa Government.
- 6. Offences by companies.—If the person contravening any provision of section 4 be a company or other body corporate, every director, manager, secretary or other officer or agent thereof shall, unless he proves that the contravention took place without his knowledge or that he exercised all due diligence to prevent such contravention, be deemed to be guilty of such contravention.
- 7. Cognizance of offences.—(1) No Court inferior to that of a Magistrate of the first class shall try any offence punishable under this Ordinance.
- (2) No Court shall take cognizance of any offence punishable under this Ordinance except on a complaint made in writing by a police officer not below the rank of an Assistant Sub-Inspector/an Excise Officer not below the rank of a Sub-Inspector or any other officer authorised in this behalf by the Federa Government.
- 8. Power to make rules.—The Federal Government may, by notification in the official Gazette, make rules for carrying out the purposes of this Ordinance.
