

Drive against smoking

The Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) administration has decided to launch a vigorous awareness campaign against smoking in the metropolis, a spokesman for the deputy commissioner's office said here on Tuesday.

The campaign will be launched in collaboration with officials of Ministry of Health, Is-

lamabad Traffic Police, Islamabad Chamber of Commerce and Industry (ICCI), heads of educational institutions, NGOs, business community and transporters.

A meeting in this regard was held with Deputy Commissioner (Islamabad) Amer Ali Ahmed in the chair. High-ranking officials of Ministry of Health, SSP (Traffic) Dr. Moeen Masood, ADC (G) ICT Agha Muhammad Ali, ITA

Secretary Bashir Ahmed, representatives of NGOs and Islamabad Chamber of Commerce and Industry attended the meeting.

During the first phase of drive (100 days), the target groups will be approached and given briefing on health hazards of smoking. Posters and leaflets will be distributed among the target groups. In the second phase, enforcement of anti-smoking law will be ensured.
