MRC for action against land, drug mafias

KARACHI - The Mohajir Rabita Council (MRC) on Thursday demanded President Asif Zardari, Prime Minister Yousuf Gilani, Federal Minister Rehman Malik, the Sindh Governor and the Chief Minister to take stock of the situation and order a stern action against the criminals of land and drug mafias.

In a joint statement issued from MRC office, MRC President Yaqoob Bundhani and Asrhad Siddiqui said that the criminals of land-mafia had encroached upon the prime land of the metropolis. They asked the government to take practical steps to retrieve the prime land of the metropolis from the land grabbers. They said that despite repeated demands, the government did not take any action against the land mafia.
